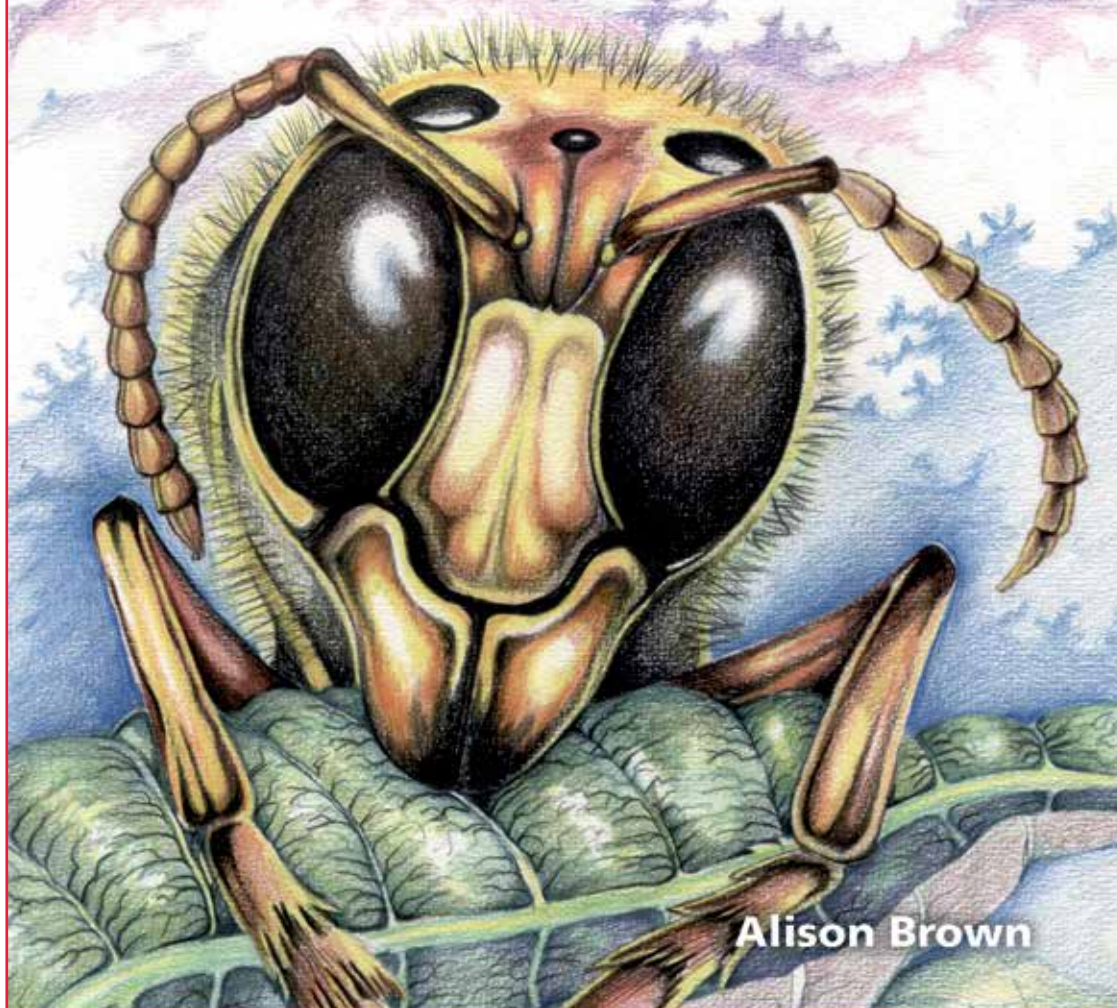

God alone is worthy of our worship because he is everlasting, and he reigns over all things!

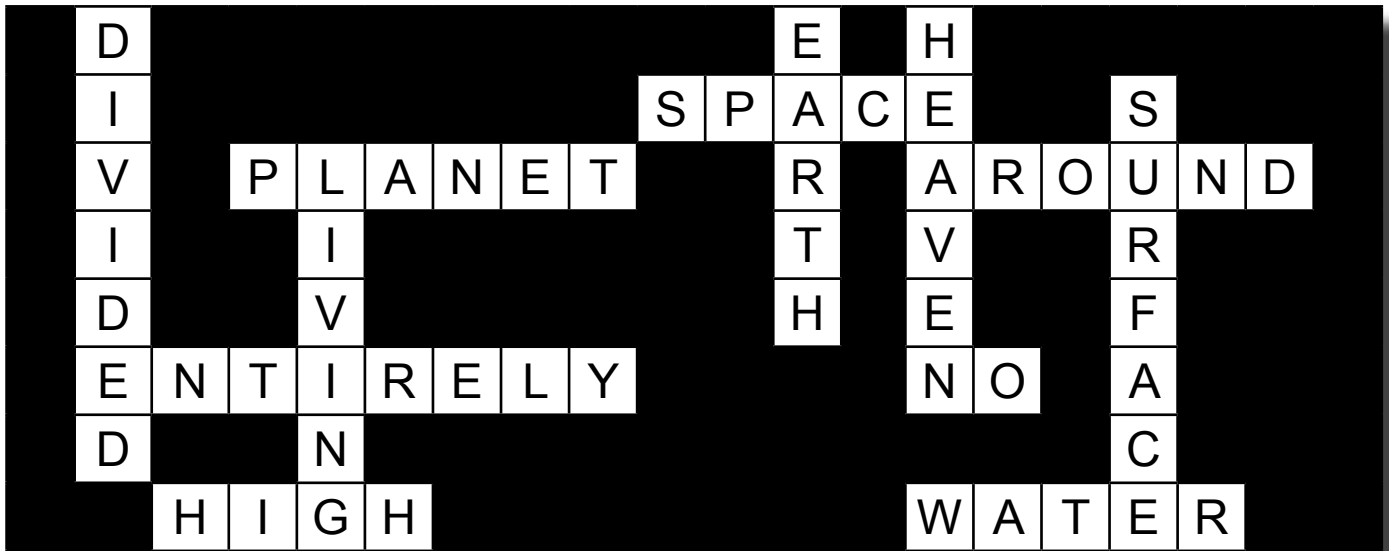
### *Colossians 1:16 (ESV)*

*And God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it was so.*

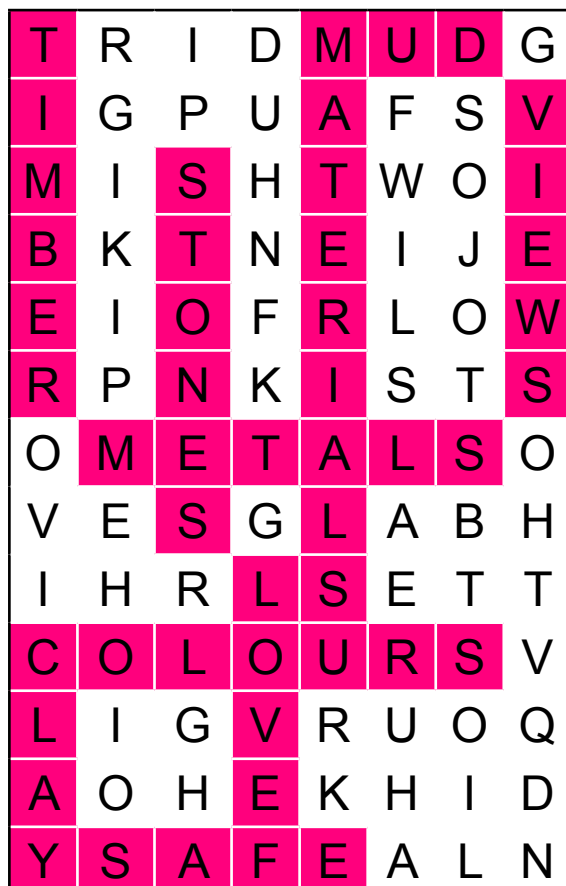
God made time and space on Day One.

On Day Three God created land, sea and plants.

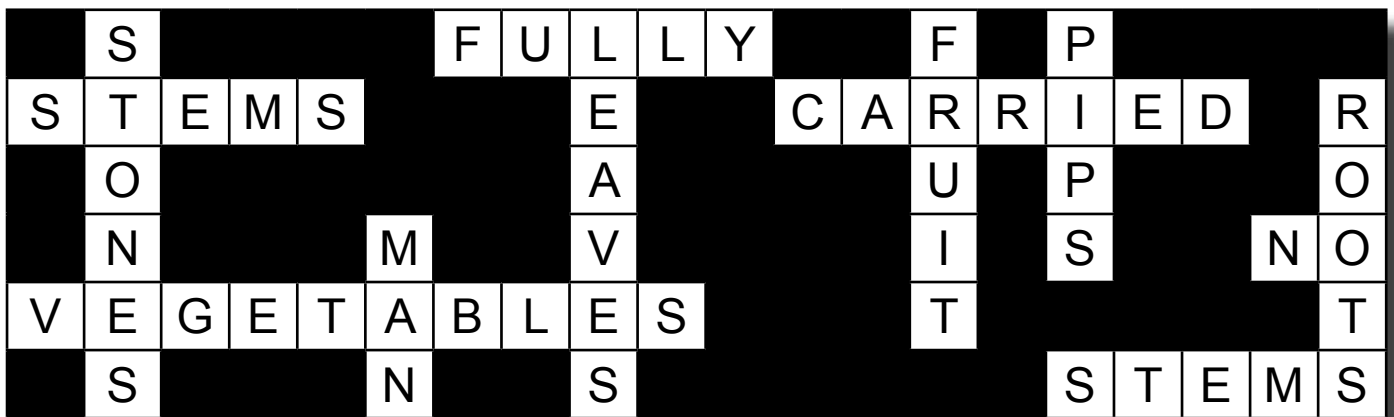
God was preparing Earth for mankind.

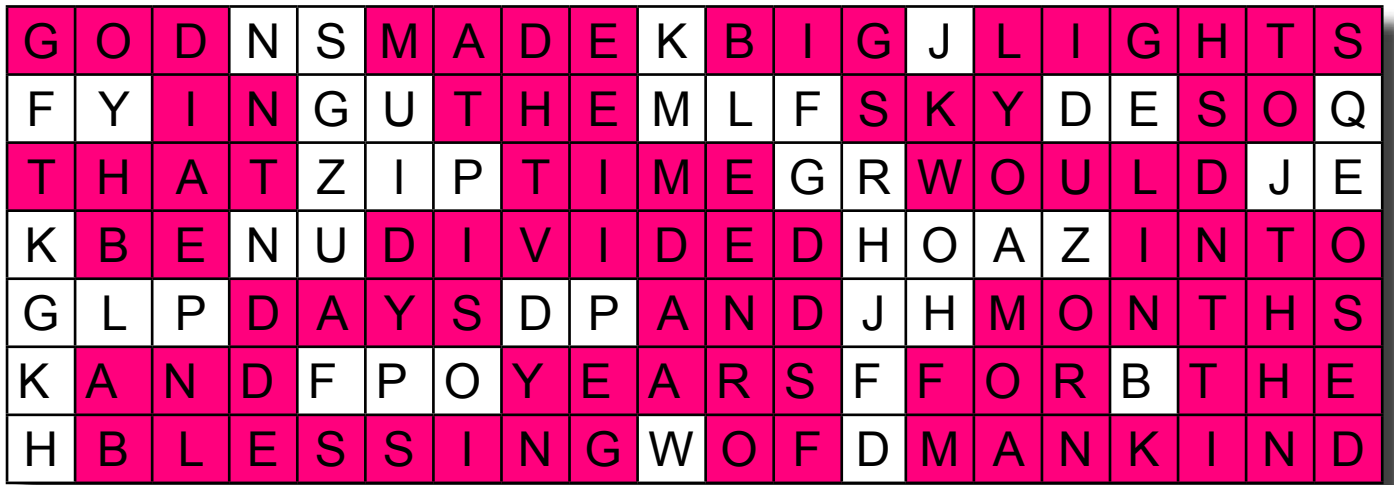

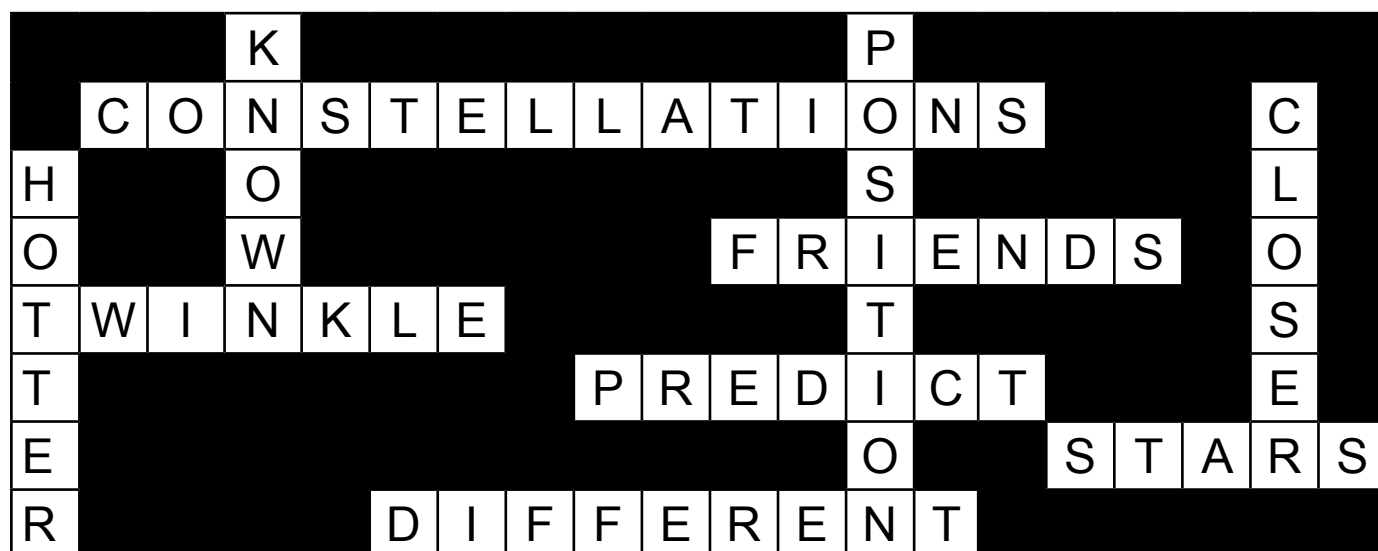

Other sea- creatures which are not fish might include...octopus, sea-horse, squid, starfish, crab, jellyfish, etc.

*Job 41* and *Isaiah 27:1* describe a huge creature called Leviathan.

Butterflies and bats were made on Day Five too.

### *Genesis 1:24 (ESV)*

*And God said, 'Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to their kinds- livestock and creeping things and beasts of the earth according to their kinds'. And it was so.*

God made birds and fish on Day Five.

God made plants before animals so that the animals would have something to eat.

God said everything he created was very good. God has different purposes for different animal kinds, and he has preserved the different kinds he created in order to prevent confusion.

### *Genesis 1:29 (ESV)*

**Page 31.***2 Corinthians 4:6 (ESV)*

*For God, who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness, has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.*

The first day of Creation, and the moment of salvation, both begin with darkness being dispelled by light!

During a Christian's life the life of Jesus Christ should be formed in him, to a greater and greater extent.

Creation and salvation both end with a place of rest.
